## **D2L Quiz - Randomize Questions**

Use Assessments > Quizzes for Quizzes / Tests / Exams

- Present <u>all</u> questions in a different order so every student's exam seems like it is different
- Present <u>only a few questions</u> out of a bigger question pool
- Group randomize questions by <u>question type</u> and <u>point values</u>

## **Best Practice:**

- Always <u>let students know</u> that the quiz / test / exam presents questions randomly
- Always <u>provide a practice test</u> so students experience it before taking the final test
- Use \*'Automatic Grade' & 'Auto Export to Grades' features
